Good Morning,

Attached is letter from Atty Ainsworth  
regarding tomorrow nights meeting.

I have copied Atty Branse in case he has any comments prior to the meeting. This email will be printed and put in the file.

My only comment, once the specific prohibition on the licensed tattoo parlors is removed, they are allowed to relocate, the use becomes permitted as a personal service shop. This is how the 2012 tattoo parlor was approved in Higganum and the 2014 Bridge Road parlor was approved.

The use has not expanded with the relocation, it has actually decreased. The Bridge Road approved footprint is 1,340 and the 310 Saybrook Road is 1,000 sq.ft. The applicant has confirmed that he has gone from 4 tattoo stations to 3 stations.
