Application for Peddlers/Solicitors Permit

PEDDLER/SOLICITOR PERMIT APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. A background check must be completed by the State of Connecticut DESPP Division of State Police before applying for the Peddler Permit. The fee for the background check is \$75.00. Make check payable to "Treasurer, State of Connecticut". Take the application to the State DESPP office at:

2. Complete all information on the Peddler Permit application and submit to the Town Clerk's Office with a copy of your driver's license and results of the background check.

3. The permit application is submitted to the First Selectman for approval. The Town Clerk's office will contact you to complete the application process when the application has been returned by the First Selectman.

4. If you have a business that is food related, you must have your equipment inspected by the town sanitarian and receive appropriate documentation. Once you have received inspection approval you may come in to complete the last step of the application process.

5. A Solicitor's License is good for 30 days and costs \$5.

6. A Peddler's Permit is good for one year and costs \$25.

Chapter 152. PEDDLING AND SOLICITING

§ 152-1. Definitions

Peddler means any person over sixteen (16) years of age, whether principal or agent, who shall go from place to place within the town selling or bartering or carrying for sale or barter or exposing therefor any goods, wares, or merchandise, either on foot or from any animal or vehicle.

Solicitor means any person over sixteen (16) years of age, whether principal or agent, who shall go from place to place within the town soliciting orders for future delivery of any goods, wares or merchandise, including magazines and other printed matter where full payment is required at the time of solicitation.

§ 152-4. Fees.

When said application shall be approved by the Selectmen, they shall refer the applicant to the Town Clerk, who shall issue the license applied for as follows: a solicitor's license for a period of 30 days upon the payment of a fee of \$5, or a peddler's license for a period of one year upon the payment of a fee of \$25, for each team or vehicle used in connection with such peddling, vending or hawking.
