Senior & Social Services:

The following programs has serviced the community:

Haddam Emergency Food Bank has serviced a total of 54 Adults & 20 Children.

Haddam Emergency Fuel Bank has serviced 1 family for oil.

Haddam Emergency Clothing Bank has serviced 5 Adults & 3 Children

Haddam Senior & Social Services has serviced 11 individuals with paperwork assistance.

3 Wellness check was done in September.

2 Meals on wheels applications were processed for October.

The Warm the Children Program has allotted Haddam 20 slots for their program and has serviced our entire waiting list of 16, making it a total of 36 children supplied with winter clothing.

Senior Van:

The Senior Van has serviced a total of 10 medical appointments for September 2019.

The weekly shopping trip has had a consistent average of 8 seniors weekly.

The senior van transported 5 seniors to the expo.

The monthly field trip had a full van which consists of 12.

Haddam Senior Center:

The Haddam Senior Center has had a total of 371 visitors for the month of October.

177 of the 371 have attended the CRT lunch program at the senior center.

The monthly Senior Center Field Trip was fully attended.

Non-CRT lunches was a total of 29.
